<u>Phase 1</u> (7 to 14 days)

1. Upon arrival and check in to the housing, you will need to inventory your personal belongings. Clothes, personal items, etc.

- 2. You will be instructed on how to use the water, propane and sewer.
- 3. You will need to wash all clothes, sheets, blankets, etc. The washer and dryer are available at the Hope Outreach day center.
- 4. If you are unemployed, you will be accountable for your time 8 hours a day. You must report to the church office by 9:00am daily. You will check back in by 5:00pm.
- 5. You will start your day by eating breakfast and bathing before you check in with your sponsor / mentor.
- 6. Some groceries are provided in the trailer and lunch is served at 11:30 at "Our daily bread".
- 7. If you need clothes, you can work for a voucher at Hope Outreach.
- 8. Your money will be accounted for weekly. Any financial gift from friends, family, etc., will be used for living expenses.
- 9. You will work 8 hours a day trying to find a job. Job hunting is your job.

<u>Phase 2</u> (15 to 30 days)

- 1. After finding a job, you will work out a schedule to fulfill your additional work obligation (5 hours per week) at the church.
- 2. All scheduling will be arranged, written out, and kept on file at the church office. This includes counseling, DHS, Prob / Parole, etc.

<u>Phase 3</u> (31 to 90 days)

- 1. Exiting the program will be planned out by you and your sponsor/ mentor.
- 2. Communication is expected daily as you will still need to check in by phone or in person.
- 3. Final cleaning of the facilities will be taken care of before your "savings / launch fund" will be released.
